

The American Water Works Association reports that utility respondents' turnover rate has doubled on a percentage basis from 2021 to 2022. And over half of non-utility respondents report struggling to fill key positions¹.

How are industries responding? In order to keep key personnel on-board, management needs to ensure that employees are engaged in fulfilling work that aligns with their core values. The days of top down "do what I say, I'm your boss!" hierarchical styles are gone. Therefore, as these employees are moved away from menial, less rewarding yet important job functions, IoT and automation must fill the vacuum. The encouraging news is that industry leaders are following suit: in the next four years, IoT applications in the Utilities market are expected to increase by more than 50%².
